I made a point of finding it while in York for the AGM. As Sylvia said, (page 28 "Dickon Independent" issue 41), go straight down the right hand side of the Minster, to the last but one window on that side, and it is just in the bottom of the window. The tomb of William Wentworth and his wife is below the window. Do take binoculars, then you can read the dedication from the Society of Friends.
